Donor Embryo FET Cycle Approximate Costs

Frozen embryo transfer involves the administration of medications to promote growth of a receptive uterine lining for implantation. An ultrasound exam is performed to confirm appropriate estrogen priming of the endometrium before progesterone support is administered.
